Call for Expressions of Interest for appointment as Deputy Chair of the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission Governing Board

Expressions of interest are sought from qualified people for appointment as the Deputy Chair of the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission Governing Board. Expertise in one or more of the following areas would be highly regarded:

- relevant industry knowledge;
- corporate governance;

- finance and accounting;
- strategic planning; and
- an understanding of the role, duties and objectives of Government.

The ACT Gambling and Racing Commission (the Commission) is an independent statutory authority established under the *Gambling and Racing Control Act 1999* (the Act). The Act provides for the continued administration of certain Acts relating to gambling and racing and establishes the powers, functions and activities of the Commission.

The Act provides that the Commission is to be controlled by a Governing Board of five members consisting of the Chief Executive Officer of the Commission and four part-time ordinary members (Chair, Deputy Chair and two other ordinary members). Members are appointed to the Board for a term of not more than three years.

Eligibility

A person is eligible to be appointed as a member of the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission Governing Board where the Government agrees that the person has the relevant experience or expertise to undertake the role and is appointed under the *Financial Management Act 1996*.

The Attorney-General, Mr Gordon Ramsay MLA, appoints eligible people to the Board.

Meetings

The Governing Board conducts formal meetings on a monthly basis. The Board considers briefing papers and recommendations regarding significant issues, including those presented to the Board by Commission staff (through Access Canberra).

Remuneration

As per the *ACT Remuneration Tribunal Determination 12 of 2016 - Part-time Public Office Holders*, the Deputy Chair is remunerated at \$24,710 per annum.

Expressions of Interest

Expressions of Interest must be in writing and include a statement addressing relevant knowledge, experience or qualifications. A detailed curriculum vitae should also be provided.
