The Attorney General, Mr Gordon Ramsay MLA, seeks expressions of interest from qualified people for the appointment of the following members of the Liquor Advisory Board:

- one member to represent the community;
- one member to represent Aboriginal people and Torres Strait Islanders;
- one member to represent small businesses;
- one member to represent club licensees ;
- one member to represent on licensees, other than club licensees;
- one member to represent young people;
- one member to represent the off-licensees; and
- one member with knowledge or expertise in the area of health and the effects of alcohol.

The Liquor Advisory Board is established under the *Liquor Act 2010* (the Act) and provides advice to the Attorney-General about matters associated with the operation and effectiveness of the Act, and measures that support the harm minimisation and community safety principles contained in the Act.

### Eligibility

A person is eligible to be appointed as a member of the Liquor Advisory Board where the Attorney-General is satisfied that the person has the relevant experience or expertise to undertake the role.

### Meetings

The Liquor Advisory Board meets at least twice each year.

### Remuneration

Membership of the Liquor Advisory Board is not remunerated. However, reimbursement of expenses reasonably incurred in attending a meeting may be payable.

### Expressions of Interest

Expressions of Interest must be in writing, include a statement addressing relevant knowledge, experience or qualifications, and be accompanied by a detailed curriculum vitae. The ACT Government encourages

and promotes the participation of a broad range of people with diverse experiences and backgrounds on ACT Government and non-government boards and committees. If you wish to declare that you identify as having an Aboriginal and / or Torres Strait Islander background; a culturally and linguistically diverse background; and / or person with a disability please indicate this in your expression of interest.
