Call for Expressions of Interest for appointment as a part-time member of the Diversification and Sustainability Support Fund Advisory Board

Expressions of interest are sought from qualified people for appointment as a part-time ordinary member of the Diversification Sustainability and Support Fund Advisory Board (the Advisory Board). Expertise in one or more of the following areas would be highly regarded:

- business strategy or financial management;
- club operations; and/or
- urban design, planning or property development.

The Advisory Board has been established to advise the Attorney-General on matters concerning the Diversification and Sustainability Support Fund, and to make recommendations about payments to be made from the Fund.

The *Gaming Machine Act 2004* (the Act) provides that the Advisory Board is to consist of up to four members, one of which must be appointed a Chairperson. Members are appointed for a term not exceeding two years.

About the Diversification and Sustainability Support Fund

The Diversification and Sustainability Support Fund was established to fund projects and initiatives that assist clubs to diversify their income to sources other than gaming machines, support the sustainability of clubs, contribute to projects that help reduce regulatory costs or improve efficiency in administration and compliance for clubs and support training and skills development for club workers, executives and members of club management committees and boards.

Eligibility

Interested persons with qualifications or experience in the abovementioned fields are invited to apply.

Please note that employees, representatives or board members of club industry associations and influential persons (and their partners) for club licensees are not eligible to apply.

Meetings

The Attorney-General is seeking applicants who are willing to be flexible and responsive to grant applications.

Remuneration

The Chair's anticipated remuneration is \$540 per diem and the anticipated remuneration for an ordinary member is \$465 per diem.

Expressions of Interest

Expressions of Interest must be in writing and include a statement no more than 2 pages long addressing relevant knowledge, experience or qualifications. A detailed curriculum vitae should also be provided.
