The Attorney-General, Mr Gordon Ramsay MLA, seeks expressions of interest from qualified people for the appointment of members of the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal as:

- Senior Member (full-time)
- Senior Member (sessional)
- Ordinary Member (sessional).

All tribunal members are appointed to hear and determine matters within the jurisdiction of the Tribunal. Expressions of interest are sought from all areas of the community, including the private, government and community sectors and across a range of professional backgrounds. Members are sought to work across a variety of matters for which the Tribunal has jurisdiction. In particular, the Tribunal will consider applications under the *Motor Accident Injuries Act 2019* from early 2020. People with medical and/or legal qualifications and experience in this area of work are encouraged to apply. People with disabilities and people of indigenous and culturally diverse backgrounds are also encouraged to apply.

A person is eligible to be appointed as a senior or ordinary member of the Tribunal where the Attorney-General is satisfied that the person has the experience or expertise to exercise the functions of a senior or ordinary member. Members will be appointed to the Tribunal for a term of 3 or 5 years.
