To achieve this the Directorate, through the Emergency Services Agency works to:

- reduce and prevent the impact of emergencies
- ensure the preparedness of the community, and
- have resources and services ready to respond to emergencies should they occur.

The [Emergency Services Agency](#) integrates the:

- ACT Ambulance Service
- ACT Fire & Rescue
- ACT State Emergency Service, and
- ACT Rural Fire Service.

These services, together with a range of supporting groups, provide risk planning, training, fleet communications and technology services.

The Agency relies on key support from the community, Territory and Commonwealth government and non-government agencies to deliver services.
