The Australian Federal Police (AFP) is responsible for providing community policing in the Australian Capital Territory. The AFP provides this service through [ACT Policing](#). These services are provided under the auspices of the Policing Arrangement between the Commonwealth and ACT Governments. The Arrangement defines the overarching powers and relationships of the parties, and provides that the ACT Government will purchase policing services from the AFP in accordance with written agreements between the ACT Police Minister, AFP Commissioner and the Chief Police Office for the ACT.
