The Justice Reform Strategy was a two year project (2014-16) which reviewed the sentencing laws and practice in the ACT. Funding for the strategy was provided by the Government in the 2014-15 budget.

The initial focus of the Justice Reform Strategy was to formulate recommendations for a community based sentencing alternative to imprisonment. The strategy also considered broader reforms, including options relating to restorative justice and therapeutic jurisprudence.

The work of the strategy was guided by an [Advisory Group](#) [PDF 46KB] with a broad membership including representatives from key government directorates, the justice sector and other agencies and academics. A series of theme-based core design workshops were held to focus on specific issues, such as therapeutic jurisprudence, and drew on the expertise available in the Territory in these areas. The project was also informed by wider consultation with a variety of stakeholders and the community, as well as a number of research projects to ensure any reforms were evidence-based.

The [Justice Reinvestment Strategy](#), also funded in the 2014-15 budget and is ongoing, intersected with the Justice Reform Strategy. Justice reinvestment is about developing a smarter, more cost-effective approach to improving criminal justice outcomes by reducing crime, improving public safety and strengthening communities.
