Access to Advice and Support

- Provide accessible and efficient community legal centres

- Implementing reforms to promote equality for people experiencing vulnerability, including people with disability
- Implement reforms to better safeguard, manage and uphold the personal, legal and financial interests of vulnerable people.

Victim Support

- Implement an 'ACT Rights of Victims Charter'
- Implement Restorative Justice for domestic violence and sexual offences

- Implement the 'Family Safety Hub' and further family violence legislative amendments

- Improve engagement through the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Justice Partnership
